this sand structure by huang yong ping isn't a castle, but it does weigh 40,000 lbs

'bank of sand, sand of bank' by <u>huang yong ping</u> is on display in new york at gladstone gallery (21st street). it is an exact 20-ton <u>sand-</u> <u>replica</u> of the former HSBC bank in shanghai, built by palmer and turner in 1923.

<u>huang yong ping's</u> 20-ton castle — made of unstable grains of sand and sturdy concrete — is commentary on the original structure's curiously contradictory life thus far. it was a neoclassical landmark, then, after the chinese revolution of 1949, it was a communist government building, and then in the 90s it became a pudong development bank building. the structure has seen some changes and some unstable times; ironically, all of these prior purposes landmark, government, bank — were supposed to represent strength and stability.
